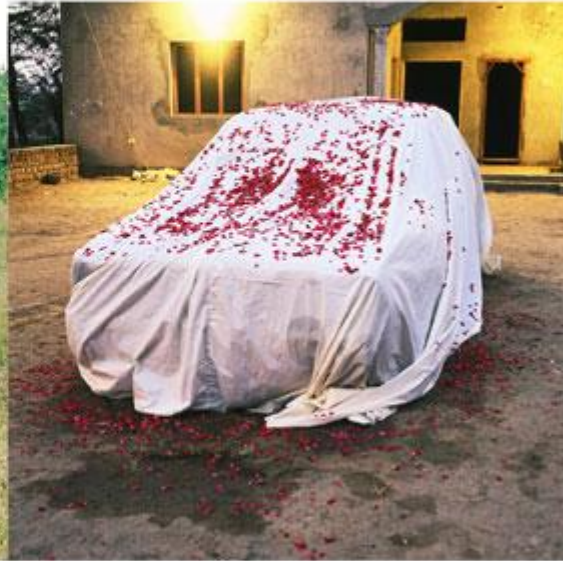

The exhibition will run from THURSDAY 26 JANUARY until THURSDAY 26 APRIL. It is open to the public and located near the 1st CLASS CHECK-IN DESKS at TERMINAL 5.

Sayed Hasan and IAMKSO have each travelled thousands of miles to Pakistan and Nigeria, in an attempt to bring their grandfathers' cars to the UK. They wish to park them side-by-side in their country of birth, but it has been an unpredictable journey. Both cars, a fragile Beetle shell and a retired, unusable hulk still await shipment, held up for reasons that reflect the politics and cultures of the countries they remain in.

My Granddads' Car is the real life story of two friends who have chosen to explore their histories, cultural heritages and identities together. For Sayed Hasan and IAMKSO identity is constantly changing and should move freely without constraint, as we form relationships in an increasingly hybridised social and cultural world.

Both artists are determined to overcome boundaries in order to reconcile their ancestral pasts with their present lives. They aspire to create a work that symbolises the challenges and joys of living in Britain in the era of globalization.

Using photography and video to document their experiences, they reveal the intimate acts and processes involved in realising their ambition, in this on-going work.
