

APPLICATION FOR A PLACE IN HALL 2010-2011

NOTES FOR RETURNING STUDENTS

General Information

- Closing date for applications is **Friday 7 May 2010**. We will accept applications after this date but they will be added to the waiting list and considered after the start of the Autumn term 2010.
- Application forms should be completed in full and photographs attached and returned to the **ACCOMMODATION OFFICE**. Any forms received by post or fax will be timed and dated as received on the day that we receive them in our office, NOT the date that they were sent. Forms **WILL NOT** be accepted without a suitable photo.
- Students who live within the 9 zones of London transport are usually placed on the waiting list. However we will look at the date the form is received in our office and the distance you live from College when placing you on the waiting list.
- Please seriously consider your financial and personal situation and note that if an offer of a place in hall is made, which you accept, this is for the **full academic year (40 weeks for undergraduates, 50 weeks for postgraduates and 40 weeks for those offered a studio in McMillan Student Village)**. We will **NOT** make refunds of fees nor deposits in the event of an early departure (unless you are withdrawing from course).
- If you would like to share a flat with friends, please make sure **ALL** of you mark this clearly on your application forms and hand them in fastened to each other. Please note we will try our best to accommodate your requests but we cannot guarantee this. Details of specific flats and rooms will not be available until you come to sign for your keys in September.
- Hall allocations will normally be dealt with on a 'first come, first served' basis considering the date the application was received in our office and distance you live from College, within the deadline stated above. Please be aware that places are limited.
- We aim to accommodate your preferences however should you be made an offer and this is not in your preferred hall you can choose to reject this offer. Please note however that should you wish to remain on our list, your application will be placed on the waiting list and it is likely that we will not be in a position to offer you another place in halls until after the start of the Autumn term 2010.
- Students who have a disciplinary record or who have a poor record of managing their fee payments, will **NOT** be considered for a place in hall.

- Please note all the halls are **NON SMOKING**, including study bedrooms.
