**The Subject Librarian for Education** is Mark Preston ([m.preston@gold.ac.uk](mailto:m.preston@gold.ac.uk)). Education enquiries can be made at Library enquiry desks, open from 10 - 5 during the week in term time.

### **Books**

are arranged on the shelves by subject using Dewey Decimal Classification. The Education section is on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor in the 370s, but you will need to look at other sections as well, such as Oversize. Please see below for some relevant subjects and their shelf numbers.

### **Journals**

are arranged by shelf number on the appropriate floor, i.e. social sciences, education and language on the 1st floor, and art, music and literature on the 2nd floor. Most journals are on open access, but some back issues are kept in the closed stack : for these, fill out request slips in Special Collections, and library staff will collect them for you.

### **Electronic journals**

are regularly added to the catalogue and can also be seen from the library web pages. Our subscriptions include JSTOR, Ingenta, and Science Direct Online (useful for social and psychological aspects of education). Many e-journals can be accessed from outside college with your Goldsmiths username and password. Please ask at an enquiry desk for further details.

on each floor of the Library contain encyclopedias, bibliographies, dictionaries, directories, government statistics and education yearbooks.

### **The School Practice collection**

on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor contains books, audiovisual and multimedia items for use with children, including school text-books, CDs and DVDs, and teaching objects.

### **Other libraries**

available to Goldsmiths' students for reference use include colleges of the University of London, such as the Institute of Education.
