*'The brigade General ordered that a farm house, known as the 'white house,' about 300 yards in advance of our fire trenches and about 150-200 yards from the Turkish trenches should be occupied and put in a state of defence that night. Captain Loring with F. Squadron was detailed to carry out this operation. At 18:30pm Captain Loring, after a personal reconnaissance occupied the 'white house,' which was empty and pushing out a small covering party, preceded to entrench between the house and the Turkish trenches. The parties were subject to a hot fire and the following casualties occurred; Captain William Loring wounded, compound fracture of the thigh, No.5047 lance corporal D.J Clow, 5307, Private G Anderson, both of F. Squadron, wounded.'*
