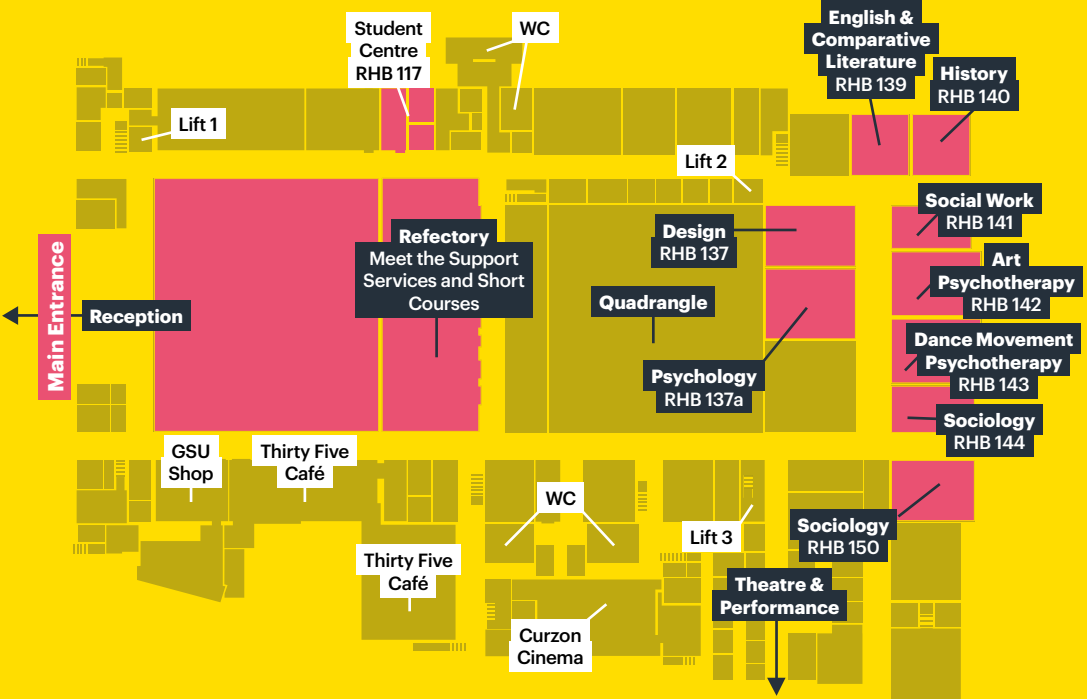

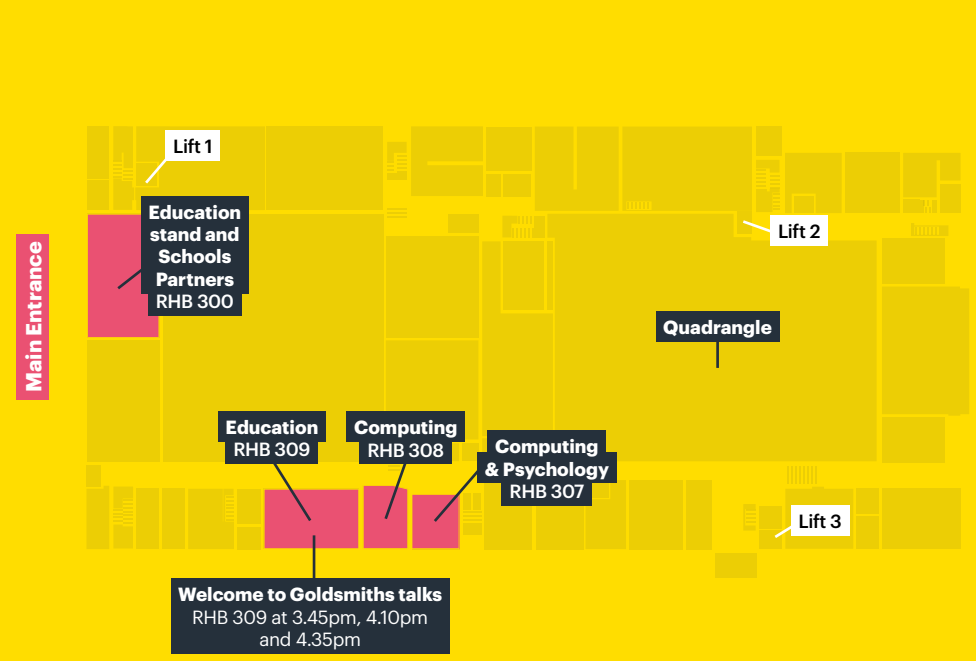

RHB 2ND FLOOR



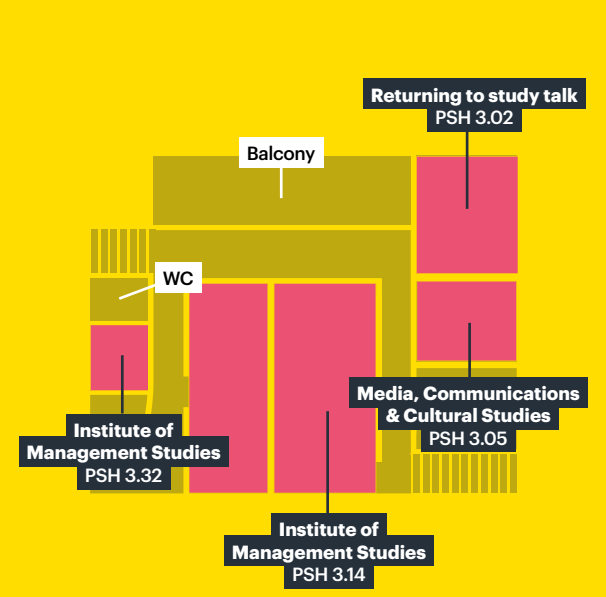
RHB 1ST FLOOR
