Be free to be yourself

This wonderful patchwork of buildings makes up our friendly campus. And it echoes the feeling that Goldsmiths is a place where all are welcome, and you are free to be yourself. Whether you're into feminism, photography or football, you can find like-minded people. And there'll probably be an event coming up where you can join in or hear some visiting experts give their opinions on it.

Places to get involved

There are lots of ways to meet friends and get involved in fun activities. During Welcome Week we organise BBQs, games, film screenings and local area tours to help you settle in. At our Freshers' Fayre you can explore our sports clubs and student societies that cover everything from anime to enterprise to gaming and musical theatre. The Students' Union runs social and cultural events, and there are lots of places around campus where you can eat, drink and relax.



Accommodation

Accommodation options for your first year include halls of residence on and near the campus, or more independent living that lets you mix with a wider student population. We placed more than 2,000 students in accommodation owned or managed by Goldsmiths last year. We'll send you more information about how to apply for accommodation in our halls of residence over the coming months.

If you want to explore private rental opportunities, the University of London Housing Services can give you advice (housing.london.ac.uk), and the Goldsmiths Students' Union holds events where you can meet future flatmates. There's also an official Facebook group where you can find people to buddy up with, and search for rental opportunities just look for 'Goldsmiths SU - Housing Group OFFICIAL'.

What happens next

There are different ways to accept your offer, depending on how you made your application. If you applied through UCAS, log into UCAS Track. Please remember any deadlines - these are listed on the UCAS website. If you applied direct to us, you can accept your offer by logging in to your online account at gold.ac.uk/mygoldsmiths

If you have an unconditional offer, send us your official results, certificates or transcripts. If you have a conditional offer, send them to us once you have met any academic or English language conditions (deadlines for these are in your terms and conditions document). Email them to admissions@gold.ac.uk



Once you have firmly accepted your offer, make your Advanced Payment (unless you are exempt*). This payment is required before we can finalise a CAS request. If you don't need a CAS statement then payment must be made before you enrol.

If you need a student visa, the process for applying for one usually starts at the beginning of July, if your studies start in September. Our Immigration Advisory Service will email you throughout the year with
