

## Eduroam set up on Chromebook

This guide will allow you to manually access the eduroam Wi-Fi network on your Chromebook device.

1. Choose **eduroam** in the list of available wireless networks
2. Select **Configure** at the bottom of the list
  - a. Under **EAP method** dropdown menu select **PEAP**
  - b. Under **Phase 2 authentication** select from the dropdown **MSCHAPv2**
  - c. In the **Identity** field enter your **username@campus.goldsmiths.ac.uk**  
*e.g. jblog014@campus.goldsmiths.ac.uk*
  - d. In the **Password** field enter your password
  - e. Leave **Anonymous identity** empty
  - f. Tick the **Save identity and password** option and click the **Connect** button
3. Click **Continue** button when prompted
